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**Employment Training Panel Approves \$8.3 Million  
to Train More Than 9,100 Workers**

*\$745,000 Awarded to the Northern California Elevator Industry Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee Trust Fund to Train 680 Apprenticeship and Journeymen in Elevator Mechanics*

SACRAMENTO – The State of California’s Employment Training Panel announced today it approved 38 contracts worth more than \$8.3 million to train 9,132 workers. The panel awarded nearly \$745,000 to the Northern California Elevator Industry Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee Trust Fund to train 680 apprentices and journeymen in the building and maintenance of elevators and escalators.

“The number of apprentice elevator constructors and mechanics has doubled in recent years, and these training funds will support the education and career advancement of Northern California apprentice and journeymen elevator constructors and mechanics,” said Employment Training Panel executive director Stewart Knox.

The Northern California Elevator Industry Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee Trust Fund was established in 2004 and covers 46 Northern California counties. Workers are employed in companies that build, install, repair, modernize and provide long-term service to elevators, escalators, chairlifts, moving walkways and similar equipment in buildings. The job training funds awarded today will assist the organization’s 540 apprentices and 840 journeymen elevator constructors and mechanics with more hands-on training and expand the use of virtual, three-dimensional computer programs on elevator and escalator training devices.

“We have doubled the number of our apprentices over the last three years to meet the high demand of our employers,” said Northern California Elevator Industry Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee coordinator James Leonard. “ETP funds are vital in helping us update our program by adding training through computer simulations and virtual elevators.”

Workers under the Joint Apprenticeship are represented by the International Union of Elevator Constructors Local 8 and Employers are represented by the National Elevator Bargaining Association and the Elevator Contractors of America. The Northern California Elevator Industry Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee Trust Fund also participates in Helmets to Hardhats which will provide 40 veterans accelerated admission to its apprenticeship program.

The Employment Training Panel is the state’s premier program supporting job creation and retention through training. The panel reimburses employers for the costs of training existing workers, funds training for unemployed workers to re-enter the workforce and helps to ensure California businesses have the skilled workers they need to remain competitive.
