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Employment Training Panel Awards \$9.2 Million to Train Nearly 9,400 Workers

Asian Neighborhood Design to Receive \$196,000 to Train 46 Workers in Construction and Green Technology

SACRAMENTO – The State of California's Employment Training Panel announced today it awarded 29 contracts worth \$9.2 million to train 9,372 workers. In one contract, the panel awarded \$195,714 to Asian Neighborhood Design to help train 46 workers in construction and green technology skills.

"The Employment Training Panel supports job training that prepares workers for good-paying jobs and careers, and meets employers' needs for skilled workers," said Stewart Knox, the Employment Training Panel's executive director. "Today's approved contracts include funding to help train individuals that face challenges and barriers to employment, including at-risk youth, veterans, the formerly incarcerated, immigrants and people with disabilities."

Asian Neighborhood Design is a non-profit architecture, community planning, employment training and support services organization in San Francisco. Since 1973, Asian Neighborhood Design has been training disadvantaged adults, young adults and low-income residents with multiple barriers to employment to gain employment in construction trades and become self-sufficient.

"Funding from ETP will allow us to further our mission of reducing poverty, revitalizing neighborhoods, building healthy communities and providing opportunities for low-income residents to become economically self-sufficient," said Asian Neighborhood Design director of programs Jamie Fountain.

The Panel's approved proposal for Asian Neighborhood Design will provide training in construction to employees with little or no work experience, and to individuals lacking literacy and vocational skills. Employees will be trained in basic electrical, carpentry, framing, dry-wall installation, siding, stairs, painting, ironwork, cement masonry and roofing skills. Workers will have the opportunity to work on large scale Bay Area construction projects that include the \$840 million SF Muni Light Rail and the \$600 million St. Luke's Campus California Pacific Medical Center.

Funds will also support training in skills necessary for long-term employment, including literacy, measuring and basic math skills relevant to green construction, solar photovoltaic installation and environmental services. Asian Neighborhood Design provides one-on-one intensive case management which includes job referrals and ongoing assistance for up to two years.

The Employment Training Panel is the state's premier program supporting job creation and retention through training. The panel reimburses employers for the costs of training existing workers, funds training for unemployed workers to re-enter the workforce and helps to ensure California businesses have the skilled workers they need to remain competitive.
