### **Employment Training Panel Approves Nearly \$6.9 Million To Train More Than 7,500 Workers**

*Certified Aviation Services Receives Contract to Train 130 Employees, Including 25 Veterans*

SACRAMENTO – The State of California’s Employment Training Panel announced the approval of 22 contracts worth more than \$6.8 million to train 7,864 workers. One of the contracts approved by the Panel includes \$492,000 to train 130 employees – including 25 veterans – at Certified Aviation Services.

“The training contracts approved today will help companies to grow by increasing the skills of their employees,” said Stewart Knox, the Employment Training Panel’s Executive Director. “The Employment Training Panel is pleased to support first-time contractors like Certified Aviation Services in offering job training that improves opportunities for workers including veterans.”

Certified Aviation Services, established in 1990, provides maintenance, repair and overhaul services – including airport line maintenance – for fleet operators. With the approval of its training proposal, Certified Aviation Services will train workers at company locations in San Diego, San Francisco, Ontario, Los Angeles and San Bernardino counties.

“With the funding from the ETP, CAS will be able to train new employees (many veterans) to be viable A&P mechanics, as well as give our existing mechanics the additional skills necessary to work on the new types of aircraft being put into service throughout California,” said Alex Vorobieff, Certified Aviation Services Chief Financial Officer.

The approved contract will help Certified Aviation Services train new and currently employed airframe and power plant mechanics, as well as select managers and supervisors. Nearly a quarter of the employees to be trained under the training plan are newly-hired and eligible for funding through the panel’s Job Creation Initiative.

The Employment Training Panel is the state’s premier program supporting job creation and retention through training. Since its creation in 1982, the panel reimburses employers for the costs of training existing workers, funds training for unemployed workers to re-enter the workforce and helps to ensure California businesses have the skilled workers they need to remain competitive.
