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Employment Training Panel Approves \$7 Million to Train Nearly 8,800 Workers

\$600,000 awarded to Studio Arts, Ltd. to train 600 in advanced technologies for jobs in multimedia and entertainment

SACRAMENTO – The State of California's Employment Training Panel today announced it approved 52 contracts worth \$7 million to train nearly 8,800 workers. The panel awarded more than \$600,000 to Studio Arts, Ltd. to train 600 workers in advanced technologies used in motion picture, television and post-production.

"The entertainment industry has a high demand for workers trained in the latest advanced technologies," said Employment Training Panel executive director Stewart Knox. "The funds awarded today will be used to train workers in the high-tech skills needed to succeed in good paying jobs in entertainment."

Studio Arts, Ltd. in Los Angeles provides training in computer-based software and hardware used in motion pictures, television production, visual effects, gaming and online streaming.

"Our focus at Studio Arts is to educate frontline artists, technicians and other workers keep up with new global trends in the fiercely competitive entertainment industry," said Eric Huelsman, president of Studio Arts, Ltd. "With these funds we will be able to train people for in-demand jobs that use these advanced technologies in film and television."

The panel funding supports training in animation, art, architecture, computer science, computer programming, interior design and production design. The majority of training will be delivered by industry experts in classrooms equipped with state-of-the-art, production-ready equipment and software.

The Employment Training Panel is the state's premier program supporting job creation and retention through training. The panel reimburses employers for the costs of training existing workers, funds training for unemployed workers to re-enter the workforce and helps to ensure California businesses have the skilled workers they need to remain competitive.
