Employment Training Panel Awards More Than \$13 million to Train 9,000 Workers

Applied Materials, Inc. Awarded Nearly \$895,000 to Train 710 Employees

SACRAMENTO – The State of California's Employment Training Panel announced it approved 41 contracts worth more than \$13 million to train nearly 9,000 workers. The panel awarded nearly \$895,000 to Applied Materials, Inc. in Santa Clara to train 710 workers in the manufacturing of semiconductor chips for electronics and other technologies.

Applied Materials uses nano-manufacturing equipment, machines and tools to make input products for semiconductor wafers and chips, flat panel displays, high-density batteries, solar photovoltaic cells and modules, and other electronics.

"We are proud to support innovative businesses by helping them meet their needs for skilled workers," said Employment Training Panel Executive Director Stewart Knox. "The funds approved address job creation and retention while increasing opportunities for workers through the development of job skills and training."

Applied Materials will use the funds to train new and current employees in material sciences, advanced technology and manufacturing processes.

"At Applied Materials, our innovations make the technology shaping possible for the future," said Ajey Joshi, Engineering Director of Applied Materials. "Every employee, every process, every technology we employ reinforces our belief in innovation.
