Report to Policy Committee Re: 2020 STEPS Update

I. <u>Overview</u>:

The STEPS Program is entering its third year. STEPS, or the Summer Training and Employment Program for Students Program, is a grant issued in partnership with ETP, the CA Department of Rehabilitation, and the CA Community College Foundation, that provides funding to CA Workforce Development Boards to provide pre-vocational training and paid work experience to students with disabilities, aged 16-21.

In 2018, the first year of the grant, \$1.5M was awarded to 6 WDBs, who provided over 330 students with disabilities 7,000 hours of pre-vocational training in topics such as interview skills, applications, communication, and customer service. These students were also placed in employment in local businesses such as retail establishments, restaurants, non-profits, offices, gyms, and child care centers, where they received 60,000 hours of paid work experience.

In the second year of the grant, funding more than doubled to \$3.15M, which was awarded to 9 WDBs, and the number of students served similarly increased.

This year, funding has increased again, and a total of \$4M was awarded to 9 WDBs, who have the opportunity to renew their grants next year with the same terms if their activities this year are successful and funding remains available. Here are this year's awardees:
