Employment Training Panel Awards \$8 million to Train 6,300 Workers

Trillium Pumps USA receives \$130,000 in Training Funds That Create New Jobs for Californians

SACRAMENTO – The State of California’s Employment Training Panel announced that it approved 28 contracts worth nearly \$8 million in job training funds for 6,300 workers. The Panel awarded \$131,008 to Trillium Pumps USA, Inc. to hire and train 100 employees in the manufacturing industry.

“The Employment Training Panel is proud to support industries that increase career opportunities for Californians, while also meeting employers’ needs for skilled workers that help to grow businesses” said Reg Javier, Employment Training Panel Executive Director.

Trillium Pumps is a fully integrated manufacturer of vertical turbine pumps for water and wastewater, oil and gas, mining, energy, and industrial markets. Based on Trilliums Pumps’ planned expansion and commitment to adding new jobs in California, the Governor’s Office of Business and Economic Development has designated this project as a Critical Proposal.

The Company will train new and existing trainees on technical and system knowledge. Training under this project will ensure workers can adapt to evolving systems, product lines, expanded teams, and customer requirements.

With new machinery such as CNC, Fabrication, Laser and Brake Machines transitioning to Trillium Pumps’ location in Fresno, production workers will focus on skills needed such as new system software, blueprints interpretation, welding, machine maintenance, and troubleshooting training to competently operate the equipment.

Workers completing training under Trillium Pumps’ contract will receive a range of operational, safety handling, quality management, and supply chain optimization skills. Gaining such knowledge and training will enable the company to manufacture an even wider range of pump product lines, and expand the company’s manufacturing capability.

The Employment Training Panel is the state’s premier program, supporting job creation and retention through training. Trainees working in this high unemployment area with unemployment exceeding the state average by at least 25%, substantiates that funding projects like Trillium Pumps contributes to a healthier economy by upskilling Californians, and providing high-wage jobs.
