- Role of MECS
 - Provides Center-Based Retraining to Participating Employers
 - Pass Through Contract Holder (Holds contract but does not provide training)
 - Employers
 - Organization
 - Training Agency
 - Hybrid (Center-Based and Employer-Based)
 - New Hire Training
- Participating Employers (PE)
 - How are they obtained
 - Require PE letters
 - Any way to attract new PEs

*Apprenticeships are MECs; however they are not part of this discussion **Single Employers are covered in general since they are more straightforward.

- Presenting case-by-case situations to the Panel

Improving Proposals

- Panel Proposal
